Check-In Time

Check-in time begins at 4pm or as rooms become available. However, you are welcome to play in the waterpark as early as 1pm. In the event that your room is not ready, we recommend that you pack a smaller bag with bathing suits and swim gear and leave the rest of your luggage locked in your car. Stop by the front desk to let us know you're here and pick up your waterpark wrist bands. There are lockers, showers, and changing areas available for your use in the waterpark.

We require guest checking in to be at least 21 years of age. Photo ID is required upon check-in along with credit card for incidental charges.

Check-Out Time

Check-out time is 11 a.m. As our guest, please feel free to enjoy the waterpark facilities until closing.

Story Time

Join us at the GREAT Clock Tower in the lobby for story time every night just following the "Rhythm of Nature" Clock Tower show. Our younger guests often like to wear their pajamas and slippers. Check the Lodge Life activity guide (you'll get this at check in) or ask a Pack Member for details.

Waterpark Hours

The indoor waterpark is typically open from 10am to 8pm* daily. You may start using the waterpark at 1:00PM on the day of check in until close on the day of departure. Check in to your suite begins at 4:00PM; therefore, we recommend locking your luggage in your car and bringing in a small bag with your bathing suits so that you can begin playing in the park. *Hours subject to change seasonally.

Cleanliness

Our resorts consistently rank in the top 5% of resort hotels in cleanliness – as measured by you, our guests! Our housekeeping staff works tirelessly to ensure each room is cleaned to the highest standards and to keep our common areas spotless. Our waterpark utilizes state-of-the-art water purification equipment to ensure our water is as clean as possible for our guests. To minimize the noxious effects of chemicals like chlorine, Great Wolf has developed industry-leading technology to balance effectiveness and guest comfort. We use ultra-violet purification technology to ensure that viruses and bacteria that could escape chlorination are effectively eliminated. Lastly, our cleanliness standards require that we enforce our rules regarding swim diapers: all diaper dependant guests must wear waterproof swim diapers while in our waterpark area.

Safety

You'll see the 100's of lifeguards we employ as part of our Risk Management Program and you may observe some of the regular drills and tests performed during operations. What you may not see, is the extensive training and certification these guards receive through aquatic risk management authority Ellis & Associates.

What to Bring

Veterans recommend a few essentials for the Great Wolf Lodge experience:

- Swimsuit/Cover-Up

- Plastic bag to carry wet suits home
- Swim goggles, Earplugs, Flip flops, Aqua socks
- Waterproof watch
- Exercise clothing
- Reading materials

Warm PJs/Slippers to wear to Story Time

Towels

Towels are provided for your family in the waterpark as well as bathing towels in your suite. You may wish to bring a beach towel or cover up as we ask that the towels stay in the waterpark area.

From Detroit, MI, Toledo, OH, Dayton and OH (North):

Take I-75 south to I-275 east (exit 16) towards Columbus, to I-71. Follow I-71 to exit 24 (Western Row Rd). Bear left on Kings Island Drive.

From Columbus, OH (East):

Take I-71 south to exit 25 (Kings Mill Rd). Turn left on Kings Mill Road. Turn right on King's Island Drive.

From Indianapolis, IN (West):

Take I-74 east to I-275 north towards Dayton to I-71 north to exit 24 (Western Row Rd). Bear left on Kings Island Drive.

From Louisville, KY and Cincinnati, OH (South):

Take I-71 north to exit 24 (Western Row Rd). Bear left on Kings Island Drive.



What is Kings Island?

With a variety of entertainment for all ages, Kings Island offers more than 80 state-of-the-art rides, shows and attractions, including 14 thrill-inducing and world-record holding roller coasters, a 15-acre water park, fun-filled musical productions, games of skill, and an assortment of dining facilities, snack outlets and shops. There's something for everyone at Kings Island.

What are the operating hours for the park?

The park is open from 10 am to 10 pm and Boomerang Bay is open from 11 am to 7 pm.

What happens if it rains?

Some attractions may close in inclement weather until conditions permit safe operation. Please enjoy a live show, meal or shopping until such weather passes. Kings Island cannot issue rain checks or refunds for inclement weather.

May I bring my own food and beverage into Kings Island?

No outside food, beverages or coolers are allowed to be brought into Kings Island. However, special dietary needs, such as food allergies and baby food and formula are permitted.

How do I re-enter the park should I have to leave for some reason?

If you wish to leave the park and return on the same day, please have your hand stamped at the Front Gate. If you wish to leave the parking lot and re-enter, present your parking receipt to the attendant when you return.

Does Kings Island have automatic tellers (ATMs)?

There are several ATMs located throughout the park for your convenience.

What is the park policy on alcoholic beverages?

You must be 21 years of age to purchase, possess or consume alcoholic beverages at Kings Island. Valid State issued photo identification or valid driver's license is required upon request for each person purchasing, possessing or consuming alcoholic beverages. Alcoholic beverages are not permitted in any line at Kings Island.

Is smoking permitted in the park?

As we strive to accommodate all of our guests, designated smoking areas have been established throughout Kings Island. Please refer to our park map for specific locations during your visit, or ask any park associate for locations of the designated smoking areas. Smoking is not permitted in any theater, ride or waiting area.

What forms of payment does Kings Island accept?

Kings Island accepts cash, credit or debit cards from American Express, MasterCard, Visa and Discover. A valid driver's license must be presented when using a credit card for purchases at the park.

Is there a place to store my belongings inside the park?

Lockers are available for rent at the Front Gate, across from the Festhaus in Oktoberfest, near the Crypt in Rivertown, Firehawk in Coney Mall and in Boomerang Bay.

Where can I find the best deal on tickets?

The best deals on tickets are available online \$33.00. Pay Once, Visit Twice is one of the most popular ticket options for \$48.99.

What does my Kings Island admission ticket include?

Your admission to Kings Island includes all rides, live shows and attractions, including Boomerang Bay. Your admission ticket does not include three paid attractions (Sling Shot, Thunder Alley and Xtreme Flyer) or events which require a separate admission.

How much is parking?

Kings Island offers regular parking (all vehicles) for \$10 and preferred parking for \$15.

What is an e-ticket?

E-tickets let you purchase and print your tickets from the convenience of home. This option allows you to bypass having to wait in line at the ticket windows when you arrive at the park. With an e-ticket, you simply proceed to the Front Gate.

What should I do if I can't print my online tickets?

No need to panic. You can have your tickets printed for you at Will Call. You will need the credit card you used to purchase the e-ticket and your confirmation number.

Does Kings Island offer a discount on admission for groups?

Yes, groups of 15 or more are eligible for a group discount—the price will be \$30.99. Call 513-754-5701.

Is there a dress code at Kings Island?

Shirts, shorts/pants and shoes must be worn at all times. Proper swimming attire for Boomerang Bay is defined as one or two-piece swim suits without abrasive buttons, rivets, zippers or snaps.
